Waiver of Liability and Release for use of Batting Cages

I hereby acknowledge and agree that participation in the batting cages within Batting a Thousand, Let's Play Too LLC, a Baseball and Softball Training Facility has inherent risks. In consideration of the services provided by Batting a Thousand, Let's Play Too LLC, their agents, officers, participants, consultants, employees and all persons or entities acting in any capacity on their behalf (hereinafter referred to as Batting a Thousand) I now agree and certify as follows:

1. I acknowledge and fully understand that I, _____, the participant (if participants is 18 years of age or older) or parent/legal guardian of the above listed minor participant, will be engaging in activities that may involve risk of serious injury which might result not only from my own actions, inactions, or negligence, but from the actions, inactions, or negligence of others or the conditions of the premises or of any equipment used. Additionally, I hereby acknowledge and agree that participation in lessons, clinics, camps; and participation in all activities conducted within or by Batting a Thousand, facilities as well as offsite activities sponsored by Batting a Thousand have inherent risks. Further, that there may be other risks not known or not reasonably foreseeable at this time. The risks may include, but are not limited to: nature of the activity, latent or apparent defects of conditions in equipment or property supplied by Batting a Thousand or other entity; acts of other participants in this activity, employees or agents of Batting a Thousand; my own physical condition, acts of omissions; conditions of Batting a Thousand facility and surrounding grounds or terrain and accidents connected with their use; first aid emergency treatment or other services.

I hereby certify that I have adequate insurance to cover any injury or damage I may cause or suffer while participating in these activities or alternatively I agree to bear the cost of such injury or damage myself. I further certify that I have no medical or physical conditions, which could interfere with my safety in this activity, or else I am willing to assume and bear the costs of all risk that may be created, directly or indirectly, by any such condition.

5. I hereby certify that I am at least 18 years old, or the part or legal guardian of the participant under 18, and I agree I will wear a batting helmet at all times while in the batting cages. I hereby provide Batting a Thousand permission to administer basic first aid and I authorize Batting a Thousand or its agents or employees to contact 911 or other emergency personnel as needed.

6. I hereby certify that I have been given the Rules & Regulations for batting cage use and will adhere to them.

7. I do hereby give Batting a Thousand its assigns, licensees, and legal representatives the irrevocable right to use photographs or video in all forms and media and in all manners, including composite, for advertising or marketing for publication or any other lawful purposes, and I waive any right to inspect or approve the finished product, including written copy, internet, etc., which may be created in connection therewith.

By signing this document, I acknowledge that if anyone is hurt, or property is damaged during participation in this activity a court of law may find me to have waived my right to maintain a lawsuit against Batting a Thousand on the basis of any claim from which I have release them herein. Batting Cage Rules

- A. Batters MUST wear helmets inside tunnels at all times.
- B. Only Batting a Thousand personnel are permitted to adjust pitching machines.
- C. A waiver must be signed before use of any of the equipment by any user who is 18 years of age or older (Parent/guardian must sign for any minors).
- D. Adults are responsible for the actions of the youth in the training area. Misconduct will result in immediate termination of privileges. Horseplay/fooling around will not be tolerated.
- E. No food or drink allowed in the training areas.
- F. All balls must be picked up and returned to their proper place after use.
- G. Batters must wear appropriate shoes. (No Cleats)
- H. No person under the influence of Drugs or Alcohol is permitted to use the batting cages.
- I. Alert the attendant immediately if balls are throwing out of strike zone.
- J. Balls may be pitched at any time. BE ALERT at all times.
- K. No one under the age of 6 years old is permitted to use the pitching machines.
 - L. Anyone under the age of 16 must have adult supervision on site. Helmets and bats must be provided by the user.
- M. The only people swinging a bat are those inside the individual tunnels.
 - N. Do not throw balls back at pitching machines.
- O. No gum or sunflower seeds may be chewed while in the facility.
- P. To limit clutter and tripping hazards we encourage all sports bags to remain in your vehicle. Only bring in equipment that is needed. Example helmet and bat only.
- Q. No pulling or hanging on any of the netting in the batting cages and/or surrounding the training area.
- R. CAUTION! Injuries could result from the use of these devices. Users should assume the inherent risks of batting baseballs and softballs. If users have any questions about the use of these devices or the inherent risks associated with the use of these devices, ask the attendant before using the batting cages.
